Description of Revenue Sources

To this revenue head are credited all fees and charges received by the Government, except fees charged by government utilities which are credited to Head 10—Utilities and Head 6—Royalties and Concessions (in respect of government toll-tunnels and bridges). Fees and charges are payable for services provided by bureaux, departments and government agencies. It is the Government's general policy that the cost of such services should be fully recovered from the fees imposed or the charges made. Certain essential services are subsidised by the Government, or provided free

Revenue from fees and charges generated 3.5% of general revenue in 2003–04.

Underlying Changes in Revenue Yield

The **2003–04** revised estimate of \$10,368,901,000 is a net decrease of \$508,503,000 (4.7%) against the original estimate.

Under Subhead 031 Customs and Excise Department the increase of \$76,008,000 (10.6%) is mainly due to the higher than expected number of trade declarations.

Under Subhead 037 Department of Health the decrease of \$28,730,000 (18.0%) is mainly due to the lower than expected numbers of candidates taking the Chinese Medicine licensing examinations and applications for registration of proprietary Chinese Medicines.

Under Subhead 044 Environmental Protection Department the decrease of \$14,421,000 (14.6%) is mainly due to the lower than expected quantity of chemical waste intake.

Under Subhead 049 Food and Environmental Hygiene Department the decrease of \$128,395,000 (40.0%) is mainly due to the one-year waiver of various licence fees as part of the SARS relief measures.

Under Subhead 050 Government Land Transport Agency the revenue received after 1 July 2003 is now grouped under a new Subhead 059 Government Logistics Department following the merger of Government Land Transport Agency, Government Supplies Department and Printing Department.

Under Subhead 058 Government Supplies Department the revenue received after 1 July 2003 is now grouped under a new Subhead 059 Government Logistics Department following the merger of Government Land Transport Agency, Government Supplies Department and Printing Department.

Under Subhead 059 Government Logistics Department the revenue of Government Land Transport Agency, Government Supplies Department and Printing Department is now grouped under this new subhead following their merger.

Under Subhead 060 Highways Department the decrease of \$38,629,000 (90.7%) is mainly due to the deferral of the implementation of the excavation permit charging scheme.

Under Subhead 078 Intellectual Property Department the increase of \$28,493,000 (25.0%) is mainly due to the higher than expected number of certificates of registration issued under the old Trade Marks Ordinance (Cap.43).

Under Subhead 080 Judiciary the decrease of \$29,647,000 (10.9%) is mainly due to the lower than expected number of cases attracting court fees.

Under Subhead 082 Buildings Department the decrease of \$42,420,000 (30.7%) is mainly due to the lower than expected number of building plans submissions.

Under Subhead 091 Lands Department the increase of \$39,455,000 (10.2%) is mainly due to the higher than expected recovery of service charges from the Kowloon-Canton Railway Corporation.

Under Subhead 110 Territory Development Department the decrease of \$14,662,000 (89.6%) is mainly due to the lower than expected demand for private works.

Under Subhead 115 Official Languages Agency the revenue received after 1 July 2003 is now grouped under a new Subhead 143 Government Secretariat: Civil Service Bureau following the incorporation of the Official Languages Agency into the Civil Service Bureau.

Under *Subhead 116 Official Receiver's Office* the increase of \$34,453,000 (27.5%) is mainly due to the higher than expected revenue to be collected from bankruptcy cases.

Under Subhead 130 Printing Department the revenue received after 1 July 2003 is now grouped under a new Subhead 059 Government Logistics Department following the merger of Government Land Transport Agency, Government Supplies Department and Printing Department.

Under Subhead 143 Government Secretariat: Civil Service Bureau the revenue of Official Languages Agency is now grouped under this new Subhead following their reorganisation.

Under Subhead 156 Government Secretariat: Education and Manpower Bureau the decrease of \$10,169,000 (10.8%) is mainly due to the lower than expected number of students taking adult education courses.

The **2004–05** estimate of \$10,375,549,000 is a net increase of \$6,648,000 (0.1%) over the revised estimate for 2003–04.

Under Subhead 029 Civil Service Training and Development Institute the revenue is now grouped under a new Subhead 143 Government Secretariat: Civil Service Bureau following the planned incorporation of the Civil Service Training and Development Institute into the Civil Service Bureau.

Under Subhead 037 Department of Health the decrease of \$19,076,000 (14.6%) is mainly due to the full year effect of the transfer of the provision of general out-patient services to the Hospital Authority.

Under Subhead 042 Electrical and Mechanical Services Department the increase of \$19,045,000 (27.7%) is mainly due to the expected increase in the triennial renewal of certificates for electrical workers and contractors.

Under Subhead 043 Civil Engineering Department the decrease of \$26,953,000 (60.2%) is mainly due to the expected decrease in the volume of mud disposal.

Under Subhead 049 Food and Environmental Hygiene Department the increase of \$122,618,000 (63.5%) is mainly due to the effect of the cessation of the one-year waiver of various licence fees as part of the SARS relief measures.

Under Subhead 060 Highways Department the increase of \$183,775,000 (4 644.3%) is mainly due to the planned implementation of the excavation permit charging scheme.

Under Subhead 078 Intellectual Property Department the decrease of \$59,391,000 (41.6%) is mainly due to the expected decrease in revenue under the old Trade Marks Ordinance (Cap.43) upon implementation of the new Trade Marks Ordinance (Cap.559) in April 2003, and the expected fee reduction following the implementation of the amendment rules for patents and registered designs.

Under *Subhead 091 Lands Department* the decrease of \$316,928,000 (74.4%) is mainly due to the expected decrease in recovery of service charges from the Kowloon-Canton Railway Corporation.

Under Subhead 116 Official Receiver's Office the decrease of \$26,000,000 (16.3%) is mainly due to the expected decrease in revenue to be collected from bankruptcy cases.

Under Subhead 143 Government Secretariat: Civil Service Bureau the revenue of Civil Service Training and Development Institute is now grouped under this new Subhead following their planned reorganisation.

Under Subhead 181 Trade and Industry Department the decrease of \$32,659,000 (17.3%) is mainly due to the expected decrease in revenue following the abolition of textile quotas.

Under *Subhead 188 Treasury* the decrease of \$11,256,000 (21.3%) is mainly due to the regrouping of revenue in respect of the services provided by the Government Logistics Department to trading funds.
