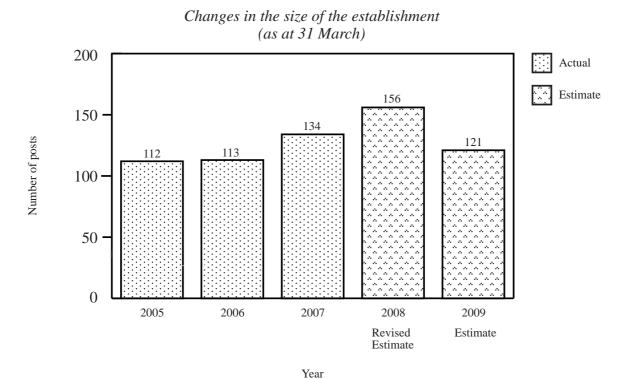

Analysis of Financial and Staffing Provision

Provision for 2008–09 is \$112.6 million (46.9%) higher than the revised estimate for 2007–08. This is mainly due to increased requirements for the conduct of the 2008 Legislative Council election, partly offset by the reduction in requirements for the 2007 District Council election and the 2007 Legislative Council by-election. There will also be a net decrease of 35 posts after the completion of the 2008 Legislative Council election.

Details of Expenditure by Subhead

The estimate of the amount required in 2008–09 for the salaries and expenses of the Registration and Electoral Office is \$352,739,000. This represents an increase of \$112,685,000 over the revised estimate for 2007–08 and of \$217,293,000 over the actual expenditure in 2006–07.

Operating Account

Recurrent

- **2** Provision of \$352,739,000 under *Subhead 000 Operational expenses* is for the salaries, allowances and other operating expenses of the Registration and Electoral Office. This represents an increase of \$112,685,000 (46.9%) over the revised estimate for 2007–08. This is mainly due to increased requirements for the conduct of the 2008 Legislative Council election, partly offset by the reduction in requirements for the 2007 District Council election and the 2007 Legislative Council by-election.
- **3** The establishment as at 31 March 2008 will be 156 posts. It is expected that there will be a net decrease of 35 posts in 2008–09. Subject to certain conditions, the controlling officer may under delegated power create or delete non-directorate posts during 2008–09, but the notional annual mid-point salary value of all such posts must not exceed \$54,540,000.
