## **Details of Expenditure by Subhead**

The estimate of the amount required in 2024–25 in respect of transfers to the various Funds established by resolution of the Legislative Council under section 29 of the Public Finance Ordinance is \$185 million. This represents a decrease of \$4,948 million against the revised estimate for 2023–24 and \$4,586 million against the actual expenditure in 2022–23.
